

# **ADDENDUM NUMBER 2**

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To Request for Qualification Holders:

This Addendum Number 2 to the above referenced Project is controlling over any other provisions of the Document to the Contrary. This addendum shall be considered a material part of the Contract Documents.

This addendum answers questions from the pre-submittal meeting of August 11.

1. Will performance bonds be required on all jobs?

All bonding shall be in accordance with state statutes. The statutes allow for various methods of performance bonds (i.e. bonds for each job order or a blanket bond for multiple jobs). The City is open to both types of bonding and will finalize the requirements with the chosen firm(s) during contract negotiations. It is possible one firm may utilize a different bonding method than another as long as state statutes are followed.

2. By using hourly billing rather than unit prices, will daily logs be required?

The City does anticipate modifying inspection procedures to accommodate the hourly format for labor and equipment. It is anticipated daily logs agreed to by the Contractor and Inspector will be utilized. Job order specific conditions may vary within the specifications for the job order.

3. How will mobilization be paid?

It is anticipated bonds, insurance, etc. will be part of a negotiated price matrix to be included in the Contract. Also burdened labor rates, equipment rates, and possibly material prices may be included depending on negotiations for each firm. Mobilization rates will also be negotiated and included in the contract as an item or as part of the price matrix. As with other items, this will be subject to negotiation.
