REGULAR MEETING

CALL TO ORDER & ROLL CALL Chairman Bowman called the meeting to order at 5:00:05. Five members were present and two members were absent at roll call, but arrived later. A quorum of members was achieved.

1. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Regular meeting minutes of August 20, 2015 **Chairman Bowman advised the commission of two minor corrections in the meeting minutes. Vice-Chairman Russell made a MOTION to approve the corrected minutes. Commissioner Longoria SECONDED the motion with a vote of 5-0.**

2. **OLD BUSINESS**
 - a. **Discussion of Distribution of Reusable Bags and Magnets.**

The Clean City Commission has purchased reusable bags and promotional magnets. The commission has requested matching bag donations from area grocery stores for distribution to the public to promote recycling and reduce plastic bag litter. The commission will discuss any activities on this matter.

The Clean City Commission discussed this item with no action taken.

 - b. **Airway Avenue Clean-ups.**

Chief DeVries has been doing on-going clean-ups using adult and juvenile 1st offender groups. The clean-ups will occur in several parts of the city, including the area along Airway Avenue near Wal-Mart and Smith's. Wal-Mart has also committed to doing monthly clean-ups in the area. The commission will receive an update on the status of the clean-ups.

3. **NEW BUSINESS**
 - a. **Follow-up on Kingman Day of Caring Clean-up.**

The Kingman Day of Caring city-wide clean-up was on September 12, 2015 in advance of the "Best of the West on Route 66" festival. The Clean City Commission conducted its Adopt-a-Highway on that day. The commission will discuss the outcome of the Kingman Day of Caring activities.

The Clean City Commission voted 5-0 on a motion to recognize the 420 volunteers who participated in the 2015 Kingman Day of Caring Clean-up by preparing a letter to the editor.

 - b. **Discussion of Plans for Rock and Roll Paint-a-Thon.**

The commission will participate in the Rock and Roll Paint-a-Thon in October. The project is directed at low income and disabled seniors in Kingman who own their own homes which need to be painted. Homes are painted through the use of local volunteers and paint supplies are donated. The commission will discuss its plans for this project. **The Clean City Commission discussed this item with no action taken.**

c. CARE Sandbox Meeting Report.

CCC Vice-Chairman Russell will make a report to the commission regarding any recent Sandbox Meeting discussions and activities. **The Clean City Commission discussed this item with no action taken.**
