Dear Industrial/Commercial Customer:

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) requires the City of Kingman to monitor the character of wastewater that the treatment plant receives from the community. The City of Kingman has begun a study to determine the typical characteristics of wastewater discharged from industrial, commercial and residential customers. Wastewater samples have been taken from the Airport Park, Hilltop and Downtown areas to help establish local limits for certain discharge to wastewater treatment facilities.

This information is extremely important to ensure the quality of operation of the Wastewater Treatment Plants and help minimize costs to our rate payers. Potential costs to industrial and commercial customers could be installation of a sampling manhole/cleanout on their sewer service line. Your facility may be visited by City of Kingman staff in the near future for additional information.

The purpose of this survey is to obtain general information needed by the City of Kingman to comply with state and federal requirements for the development of an industrial pretreatment program. Based on the results of this survey, more detailed information may be requested from some businesses. A qualified representative from your facility should fill out this survey and return it to the address below.
