CITY OF KINGMAN DRAINAGE MASTER STUDY NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The City of Kingman has entered into a contract with JE Fuller Hydrology & Geomorphology, Inc. to develop a Kingman Area Drainage Master Study (KADMS). The objective of the study is to identify the primary drainage and flooding problems within and adjacent to the City and provide recommendations for drainage solutions. A formal Kingman Area Drainage Master Study will provide guidance in budgeting for future drainage projects, help the City obtain grants and other potential funding sources to construct drainage projects and determine an approach for resolving City wide drainage issues and upgrades to the community.

The purpose of the public meeting is to provide an overview of the KADMS, identify citizen drainage issues and provide information on the current City drainage conditions. All public input is welcome and will be considered as the study is finalized.

Exhibits showing aerial photography of the existing drainage system and identified drainage issues will be presented at the meeting. Representatives from the City of Kingman and the design team will be available to answer individual questions. Comment forms will be handed out to all attendee's to document any storm drainage issues experienced by the residents of the community.

CITY OF KINGMAN DRAINAGE MASTER PLAN INFORMATION

The City of Kingman and JE Fuller Hydrology & Geomorphology, Inc. have teamed up for the purpose of developing a Kingman Area Drainage Master Plan (KADMP). The objective is to identify the primary drainage and flooding problems within and adjacent to the City and provide recommendations for drainage solutions, such that future capital improvement projects can be prioritized and budgeted. This in turn will allow the City to obtain grants and locate other potential funding sources such that projects can be constructed, and the drainage problems can be resolved on both a city-wide and local basis.

The process of developing the KADMP will be broken up into three main phases:

Phase 1 – Data Gathering and Hydrologic/Hydraulic Analyses – During this current phase of the project, steps will be taken to fully understand the primary drainage problems within the City. This includes gathering data from residents about past flood events, analyzing existing flow patterns and gaining an understanding of the source of drainage problems that residents encounter. This phase is underway. The public open house on October 29th at the City of Kingman City Hall and the compiling of the data therefrom will mark the end of this phase.

Phase 2 – Conceptual Solution Development - The following phase of the project will be to use the data that has been gathered to develop conceptual solutions that mitigate drainage issues. Solutions may range from large regional type projects to local drainage infrastructure projects. This phase is anticipated to be complete in February 2020.

Phase 3 – Concept Plan Development – Once a range of conceptual solutions have been determined, they will be prioritized, and those that will provide the substantial benefits to the community will move forward to conceptual plan development. This will provide the City with well-developed solutions and construction cost estimates for future drainage projects. A second public open house will be held near the end of this phase to present the solutions to the community. This phase is anticipated to be complete in April 2020.

All public input is welcome and encouraged. The information provided will be considered as the plan moves forward.
