Mohave County Confirms Fourth Positive COVID-19 Case

KINGMAN, Ariz. – Mohave County Department of Public Health officials have confirmed the fourth positive test for COVID-19 in the Lake Havasu City area. City of Kingman team members and elected officials are working together and collaboratively with local and statewide officials to ensure the safety of public health. Because of patient confidentiality, their name and location will not be made public.

To help contain the spread of COVID-19, health officials have issued the following recommendations:

- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Refrain from touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Don't make close contact with sick individuals.
- If you are sick, stay home.
- Cover coughs or sneezes with a tissue and throw the tissue away.
- Clean and disinfect objects that are frequently touched.
- If someone in your family tested positive for COVID-19, keep that entire household at home.
- Cancel or postpone mass gatherings of 10 or more people.

Governor Ducey's Executive Order 2020-09 regarding restaurant closures *is required* to be followed by all restaurants, bars, gyms, and movie theaters, as of the first confirmed Mohave County case March 25, 2020. Governor Ducey's [Executive Order 2020-12](#) also lays out the prohibition of the closure of essential services, which can be found here: <https://azgovernor.gov/executive-orders>

As of Monday, March 23, 2020, all city buildings (except the Municipal Courthouse, Golf Course, and Parks) will remain closed to all public access until *at least* April 6, 2020. To protect the health of our City team members and the public, all residents will be required to make requests for services remotely, through mail, email, online platforms, and telephone. City team members will be allowed into the buildings and are expected to work on-site to keep the City of Kingman operating to serve our residents. Dispatch, Fire and Police Services will operate at normal levels.
