NOTICE OF PUBLIC AUCTION
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. ALL SALES ARE FINAL
2. NO expressed or implied warranties or guarantees as to condition or fitness for use. Units are sold "AS IS, WHERE IS"
3. NOTE: These units are USED and may contain defects not immediately detectable or known about.
4. Bidders are highly encouraged to inspect prior to bidding.
5. Dents, dings, scratches or scuffs are present. City decals will be removed prior to auction. Impressions may remain.
6. Removal and loading will be done at winning bidder's expense. There will be NO removal assistance by the City of Kingman.
7. Upon auction payment verification, buyer must pre-arrange pick-up time and date with City of Kingman employees at least 24 hours in advance. No exceptions! The Bill of Sale must be presented at time of pick-up. No exceptions! Buyer/Transport Company will be turned away if removal has not been scheduled and/or Bill of Sale is not presented and/or arrival occurs outside of authorized removal hours. No exceptions! Purchaser is solely responsible for acquiring any state Motor Vehicle Department trip permits to drive unlicensed motor vehicles. Purchaser shall be solely responsible for obtaining a trip permit and to certify that the driver of the vehicle has a valid driver's license and is insured as required by state law.
8. If item is to be shipped, buyer must perform all shipping arrangements, including providing proper pick-up vehicle. Loading and transportation of all purchased items is strictly the buyer's responsibility. No service of any kind will be furnished by the City.
9. **Payment must be made within five (5) business days of close of auction. Removal must be made within ten (10) business days of close of auction. No exceptions!**
10. REMINDER: Your bid is the same as a binding contract. If you are unhappy with your purchase you do not have recourse against the City of Kingman or any of its respective directors, officers, employees or agents.
