Groups or Individuals looking to give back to our community!

- Hiking & biking groups, religious groups, schools, scout troops, neighborhood & civic associations.
- We invite individuals to Adopt-A-Park.
- We are Flexible in me commitment during program acceptance.
- We ask you visit adopted area at least once a month
- We hope; you will enjoy this & return for years!
- A typical day volunteering, approx. 2 to 4 hours.

What volunteers do?

- We welcome specific suggestion.
- Pick up litter
- Report and/or remove graffiti
- Sweep courts and/or pathways
- Pull weeds and rake leaves
- Prune and care for trees or shrubs
- Care for Plant, flowers and native plants etc.
- Trail maintenance
- Report any park hazards

Materials supplied by the City

- We ask groups attempt to supply their own materials.
- Limited supplies can be made available.
- We will:
 - partner with the groups to provide trash bags for all projects.
 - take care of all removal of trash.
 - assist in the transporting of plants, larger objects for project.
- Groups need to furnish:
 - Gloves
 - Litter stick (garbage picker-upper)
 - Gardening tools; hoes, shovels, rakes, pruning shears, and wheelbarrow.
 - Brooms and water hoses 3
 - Safety equipment; glasses, face masks, sunscreen, and first aid kit.

Groups will be recognized for their services

- At the beginning of the agreement with a press release
- On our Adopt-A-Park Recognition website page.
- After 3 months, awarded a certificate of appreciation & Recognized next PARG Commission meeting.
