The city of Kingman is pleased to announce that the Walleck Ranch and Legacy areas have been selected to participate in a pilot program for bringing the Kingman EZ Recycling Program curbside!

The City of Kingman Sanitation Department will continue to deliver recycle containers to addresses in these areas as needed. The can will have the same capacity as the current cans but will have a **blue lid** and a green body. The pilot is scheduled to run from November 2017 through June 2018 and there will be **no additional fee**. The recycling program will be single stream, **there is no need to sort or bag your recyclables**, just place them in the can with the **blue lid**.

- **Monday** will be the pickup day for the can with **green lid** for regular trash.
- **Thursday** will be the pickup day for the can with the **blue lid** for recycling.

⚠Please make sure that any food containers have been rinsed before including in your recycle. Anything too badly soiled by food or other contaminants should be thrown in the trash. Example - pizza boxes, to-go containers, etc.⚠

•Glass is not being accepted due to safety concerns. The recycling will be hand sorted and broken glass poses a hazard to personnel. You are encouraged to continue recycling your glass at the City of Kingman's various EZ Recycling Program locations.

•Plastic bags are not being accepted in the curbside recycling, but you are encouraged to continue to recycle them at the EZ Recycling Program Locations.

Depending on citizen participation, levels of contamination in the recycling, and the commodity market, the program may be terminated prior to completion. Evaluation of the program will be ongoing.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ●Americans throw away enough office paper each year to build a 12 foot high wall from Seattle to NY (a new wall every year). ●Making paper from recycled paper reduces the related contribution to air pollution 95%. ●Recycling 1 ton of cardboard saves 46 gallons of oil. ●Over 90% of all products shipped in the US are shipped in corrugated boxes, which totals more than 400 billion square feet of cardboard. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ●Every three months, Americans throw enough aluminum in the landfills to build our nation’s entire commercial air fleet. ●The average person has the opportunity to recycle more than 25,000 cans in a lifetime. ●It requires 95% less energy and water to recycle a can than to create a can from raw materials. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ●Five plastic bottles (PET) recycled provides enough fiber to create one square feet of carpet or enough fiber fill to fill one ski jacket. ●Recycling one ton of plastic bottles saves the equivalent energy usage of a two person household for one year. ●Americans throw away 2.5 million plastic bottles every hour.
